

## **MMRDA's Executive Committee Meeting held today Contractors, consultants appointed for MTHL, Metro-4, Wadala Truck Terminal and flyover on NH-4**

**Mumbai, November 9, 2017** – The Executive Committee of the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA), headed by Mr. Sumit Mallick, Chairman, Executive Committee, MMRDA and Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra, today, accorded administrative approval to the appointment of three contractors to construct all the three packages of the 22-km long Mumbai Trans Harbour Link (MTHL). The consortium of M/s. L&T-IHI has been appointed to construct Package-1, (Sewri side of the sea bridge), M/s. Daweoo-TPL (JV) has earned a nod to construct Package-2, (Navi Mumbai side of the sea bridge) and M/s. L&T has received a go-ahead to construct Package-3, the bridge portion on land towards Chirle.

The Committee also appointed M/s. Systra MVA Consulting India Pvt. Ltd. as Detail Design Consultants for the Wadala-Ghatkopar-Mulund-Thane-Kasarvadavali Metro-4 corridor.

M/s. T&T Infra Pvt. Ltd. was appointed to construct a flyover at Navade Phata Junction to improve traffic network and ease congestion on NH-4. The project includes widening of NH-4 in the arena.

“MTHL, a very important area development project, will not only provide excellent connectivity with the new airport at Panvel and for the traffic towards Pune and Goa, it will also make available vast parcels of under developed land in Navi Mumbai creating a positive impact on the development of the city. The flyover on NH-4 will rid the motorists of congestion and time consuming snarls”, said Mr. U.P.S. Madan, Metropolitan Commissioner, MMRDA. “The Wadala-Kasarvadavali Metro-4 corridor will not only provide quicker and safe mode of transport to the people from sister cities – Mumbai and Thane, it will also reduce vehicle trips on the route. The Corridor will encourage people to opt for comfortable Metro journey compared to the languishing in irritating traffic jams”, Mr. Madan said further.

The Committee also appointed M/s. Fairwood Infra and Services (P) Ltd. (JV) to provide consultancy services for design work of Architectural, Civil MEP works, Design Development, Procurement of Construction contract, supervision during construction and DLP of buildings at Wadala Truck Terminal.
