

MMRDA statement, by Mr. Dilip Kawathkar, Joint Project Director (PR), MMRDA-

The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) is constructing a 3-km long and 8.5-meter wide flyover from Rajiv Gandhi Chowk to Saibaba Mandir, on the Kalyan-Bhiwandi Road. Yesterday, January 31, 2018 around 6 pm, after the work of segment stressing was completed, unfortunately around 9 pm some parts of concrete started falling due to some technical reason and fell on the bonnet of a car parked under the flyover at Nehru Nagar between Pier 44 and 45 damaging the wind screen. Fortunately, no one is injured.

MMRDA has directed Project Management Consultants of the said work to enquire and arrive at a reason for the mishap. MMRDA will further take all necessary actions on receipt of the detailed report from the Project Management Consultants.
