

Andheri (East) to Dahisar (East) Metro-7 corridor **MMRDA Addl. Commissioner Pravin Darade visits the corridor today**

Mumbai, April 10, 2018 – Mr. Pravin Darade, Additional Commissioner, MMRDA, visited the Andheri (East) to Dahisar (East) Metro-7 corridor today and expressed his satisfaction about the progress on the project. He was accompanied by Mr. PRK Murthy, Director, Metro Projects; Mr. Tanaji Bhosale, Chief Engineer and other senior officials from MMRDA.



“This was a pre-monsoon preparation visit to ensure that the project faces minimum issues during the monsoon. We all are aware of the vagaries of Mumbai monsoon. It can throw up various riddles and catch all unawares. Of course, I was also happy to note 40% progress on the project”, said Mr. Darade.

During the visit Mr. Darade, along with his team which also included contractors and general consultants, visited Shankarwadi Station, Aarey Station and Pushpa Park Station on the corridor. He further instructed the contractors about the safety measures that need to be taken especially during monsoon and to strictly adhere to the engineering book. He interacted with officials and contractors at the Dindoshi office on the corridor.

The MMRDA is striving hard to complete the Andheri (East) to Dahisar (East) Metro-7 corridor by year 2021 at a cost of Rs. 6,208 crore. The corridor is expected to carry 4.07 lakh commuters daily in 2021.
