

CM to inaugurate two flyovers and vehicular underpass tomorrow in Thane

CM will also perform Bhoomipujan of road, tunnel and ROB

Mumbai, May 20, 2018 – The Honourable Chief Minister of Maharashtra Mr. Devendra Fadnavis will inaugurate and throw open two flyovers – at Ghansoli-Talavli and Savita Chemicals – along with a vehicular underpass tomorrow morning at 11.30. He will also perform Bhoomipujan for an elevated road and tunnel connecting Thane-Belapur Road and NH-4 and Rail Over Bridge at, Kopri, Thane.

Looks like the Chief Minister has dedicated Monday, May 21, 2018 to the people of Metropolitan Region as he will first perform Bhoomipujan of Rail Over Bridge at Kopri, Thane. This 796-m long Rail Over Bridge with 4+4 lanes is to be completed in two phases. Initially two bridges of two lanes each will be constructed on either side of the existing bridge and in the second phase the existing bridge will be dismantled to make way for a new bridge with 2+2 lanes. The project is expected to be completed in 36 months from the date of award.

Mr. Fadnavis will then proceed to inaugurate the 1.4-km long Ghansoli-Talavli flyover with 2+2 lanes consisting of 575-m long 2-lane flyover from Savita Chemicals towards Belapur and 485-m long 3-lane vehicular underpass at Mahape towards Belapur. This project crosses two overcrowded junctions at Ghansoli and Talavli.

The Chief Minister will then perform Bhoomipujan of Elevated Road and Tunnel connecting Thane-Belapur Road and NH-4. This elevated road is 3.5-km long consisting of 1.70-km long tunnel with 4+4 lanes and 1.87-km long elevated road with 3+3 lanes, which project is expected to be completed within a period of 40 months from the date of award. Mr. Fadnavis will, thereafter, address a public meeting at MIDC Industrial Area, Between Bharat Bijlee and Siemens, Thane-Belapur Road, Airoli, Navi Mumbai.
