Mumbai, June 4, 2018 - MMRDA is implementing Mumbai Metro Project of over 300 km length connecting Mumbai, Thane, Mira Road, Kalyan, Bhiwandi, etc. and Mumbai Trans Harbour Link of 22 km length in addition to several other transport and infrastructure development projects.
