

**After taking over, MMRDA runs Monorail without glitch
Retains staff
Receives great cooperation from commuters.**

Mumbai, December 21, 2018 – Ever since taking over the operations of the Monorail, the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has done extremely well to achieve 100% efficiency in operating Monorail in the first week. The Monorails are have completed all the scheduled daily trips covering 10-km distance from Wadala to Chembur and back right from 6 am to 10 pm every day.

MMRDA, in the larger public interest, terminated the contract with effect from December 14, 2018 with contractor M/s. LTSE for their failure to perform and fulfil contractual obligations, in turn, causing great inconvenience to the Monorail commuters.

During the first week (7days) of its operation, after the takeover by MMRDA, 1,08,420 commuters have travelled on the Monorail fetching Rs.7,35,175 in revenue.

The Monorail is expected to carry many more number of commuters daily once the second phase from Wadala to Sant Gadge Maharaj Chowk is commissioned.

MMRDA is committed to provide uninterrupted and efficient service to the Monorail commuters.
