Mumbai, January 10, 2019 - The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has always strived hard to safeguard workers' interests. However, the Monorail workers also are expected to maintain discipline and order of duty. MMRDA will not tolerate indiscipline and will take disciplinary action against errands.

It is only on the 14th of December, 2018 - last month - that MMRDA decided to take over operations and maintenance of Monorail from M/s. LTSE and the employees were also assured of their jobs on the same day. They must understand that there are a few rules and procedures which are required to be followed to complete the process. They cannot hold the public transport or public for ransome.
