

Making way for a flyover from Sea Link to BKC
MMRDA to pull down skywalk on WEH at Bandra on [Sat-Sun](#) nights

Mumbai, [June 21, 2019](#) – The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) will pull down the Southbound and Northbound arms of the Bandra Skywalk on the Western Express Highway (WEH) to make way for an arm of the 714-meter flyover which will land in the Bandra-Kurla Complex helping BKC-bound motorists from the time consuming wait at the Kalanagar signal.

While the Southbound arm of the skywalk will be brought down on [Saturday](#)-night from 11.00 to [Sunday](#) morning 5.00, the Northbound arm of the skywalk will be pulled down on [Sunday](#)-night during the same timeframe.

MMRDA has already received permission from the Traffic Police Department for the work which is estimated at rupees four crore.

The skywalk will again be erected in the month of [September 2019](#) after the 714-meter arm of the flyover is completed.
