

MMRDA pulls down northbound arm of skywalk on WEH at Bandra
Now flyover from Sea Link to BKC soon for you motorists!

Mumbai, June 24, 2019 – Now, the motorists will soon will be able to enter the Bandra-Kurla Complex without having to waste time at the Kalanagar signal as the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA), on **Sunday** night, pulled down the Northbound arm of the Bandra Skywalk on the Western Express Highway (WEH). The 714-meter flyover from Sea-Link, which will land in the Bandra-Kurla Complex, will now be ready within a period of 3 months.



Traffic movements were regularized immediately after the Northbound arm of the skywalk was pulled down.

The skywalk will again be erected after the 714-meter arm of the flyover is completed.
