Right side lane of 650-meter Rajnoli flyover completing soon

Six 50-meter long girders launched

Mumbai, July 6, 2019 – Vehicle owners, you no longer need to waste time at the Rajnoli Junction on the Kalyan-Bhiwandi Road as the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has launched six crucial 50-meter long steel girders, weighing 50 Metric Tonnes each. In the process 85% of the right side Rajnoli flyover work has been completed and this right side of the flyover is expected to be opened to traffic very soon. The girders were launched during early hours of July 3rd and 4th.



The right side lane of the 650-meter long 4-lane Rajnoli flyover, once completed, will rid the traffic chaos which many a time caused road rages. It will also help vehicle owners save time and fuel.

The work of this flyover was delayed due to financial problems of earlier agency, M/s. Supreme. Finally, MMRDA cancelled that contract and awarded to other agency, M/s.PS Infra in January 2019. Since then the work is being done on a war footing.
