

Segment casting for Bridge Deck Construction completed for MTHL

Mumbai, August 8, 2019 – The pre-cast segment casting, which is a pre-cursor to the super structure of Bridge Deck Construction, has been completed in the presence of Mr.Sanjay Khandare, Additional Metropolitan Commissioner, MMRDA. “The completed 75-tonne segment, with a dimension of 14.8m length x 3.32m width x 3.85m height, will be erected in the marine section at a distance of 6-km inside the sea. This is India’s longest water bridge”, informed Mr.Khandare.

The progress on the project is noteworthy, what with MMRDA completing 270 permanent piles of which 177 have been completed in the sea. The project has also completed 2-km of Temporary Access Bridge – which includes both sides – 16 Pile Caps and 10 Piers.
