

Monorail stands by 15K Mumbaikars during torrential rain

Mumbai, September 5, 2019 – Yesterday, when almost entire city halted due to torrential rains, it was a happy and comfortable experience for 14 thousand 947 Mumbaikars who travelled by the elevated Monorail from Chembur to Sant Gadge Maharaj Chowk and back. The Monorail stood by them while they needed a commute the most!

The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) also showcased great sense of timing and ran the Monorail services for two extra hours – from 11pm to 1am – for the safety of commuters.
