REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The MMRDA desires to appoint Consultants / Non-governmental Organizations (NGOs) for carrying out surveys of affected structures and PAPs and for preparation of SIA and RAP reports complying to the requirements of Multilateral / Bilateral Funding Agencies for Metro-10 (Gaimukh to Shivaji Chowk, Mira Road), Metro-11 (Wadala to CSMT) & Metro-12 (Kalyan to Taloja) as a common assignment. The period of engagement will be for 9 months for the assignment. Consultants / NGOs interested in providing the above services and satisfying the following eligibility criteria are invited to submit technical and financial proposals in writing along with necessary documents and information as per the requirements of the RFP document :

1. It should be an agency registered in India under appropriate statute enabling it to provide the specified services and should have been actively working as a Consultant / NGO for the past at least 5 years.
2. It should have the experience in carrying out cadastral and socio-economic surveys and preparation of Social Impact Assessment Report and Rehabilitation Action / Implementation Plan for at least one infrastructure project of any Government agency in India.
3. It should have at least one senior level social scientist / social worker with familiarity and experience of working on at least one infrastructure project of any Government agency in India involving application of and compliance with social safeguard policies of multilateral or bilateral funding agencies such as the World Bank, JICA, ADB etc.
4. It should have a team of qualified and experienced Social Scientists, Social Workers, computer operators, supervisors and surveyors.

The technical and financial proposals of agencies fulfilling the above conditions will be evaluated based on the criteria specified in the RFP document and the agency will be selected based on such evaluation.
