The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has applied financing from KfW towards the cost of the Wadala - Kasarvadavali -Gaimukh Metro Rail Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the Contract for DESIGN, MANUFACTURE, SUPPLY, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING OF 234 Nos. STANDARD GAUGE CARS INCLUDING TRAINING OF LINE 4 AND EXTENSION

CORRIDOR [WADALA - KASARVAVALI -GAIMUKH] OF MUMBAI METRO RAIL PROJECT OF MMRDA for which this Invitation for Bids is issued.

The Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the design, supply and installation of 234 Nos. of Standard Gauge Cars.

Bidding will be conducted by means of the International Competitive Bidding procedure with qualification as specified in the KfW Guidelines for the Procurement of Consulting Services, Works, Goods, Plant and Non-Consulting Services in Financial Cooperation with Partner Countries ("KfW Procurement Guidelines").

KfW requires that Bidders and Contractors, as well as Borrowers, under Contracts funded with KfW Loan observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such Contracts. In pursuance of this policy, Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA):

- (a) will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the Contract in question;
- (b) will recognize a Contractor as ineligible, for a period determined by MMRDA, to be awarded a Contract funded with KfW Loan if it at any times determines that the Contractor has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, another contract funded by KfW.

Single-Stage Two- Envelope:

Bidder should note that there are two envelopes. One for Technical Bid/Package and another one for Financial Bid/Package.

Further, e-tendering system of MMRDA has two sub-envelopes in Technical Bid / Package. The first sub-envelope is Envelope A which consists of Tender Security (EMD and Bank Guarantee) and Cost of Tender fee. The second sub-envelope is Envelope B which consists of all Technical Documents.

Financial Bid / Package has only one envelope i.e. Envelope C. Bidder has to submit their financial bid in Envelope C.

All Tenderers are hereby cautioned that Tender containing any material deviation or reservations as described in "Instructions to Bidders" and/or minor deviation without

quoting the impact on cost shall be considered as non-responsive and is liable to be rejected.

The intending Tenderers must be registered on e-tendering portal of MMRDA <https://etendermmrda.maharashtra.gov.in>. Those who are not registered on the e-tendering portal shall be required to get registered beforehand. If needed they can be imparted training on 'online tendering process'. After registration, the Tenderer will get user id and password. On login, Tenderer can participate in tendering process and can witness various activities of the process.

Bidders should have valid class II or III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) having both Signing and Encryption Certificates obtained from any Certifying Authorities empanelled by Controller of Certifying Authorities India. In case of requirement of DSC, Bidders should go to <https://etendermmrda.maharashtra.gov.in/files/mmrda/misc/DigitalCertificate.rar> and follow the procedure mentioned in the document Procedure for Digital Certificate.

Tender submissions will be made online after uploading the mandatory scanned documents. Bid shall be submitted online on the e-tendering portal in 'two electronic envelopes system' within prescribed schedule.

Submission of Tenders shall be closed on e-tendering portal of MMRDA on the date & time of submission prescribed in IFB after which no Tender shall be accepted.

It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that his Tender is submitted online on e-tendering portal of MMRDA before the deadline of submission. MMRDA will not be responsible for non-receipt of Tender Documents due to any delay and/or loss etc.

Since the e-tendering system shall calculate the amount of Quoted figures, which may change due to error and corrections in Foreign Currencies, the automated mail related to comparison does not depict the correct picture and hence does not hold good. The Correct status related to it shall be depicted/ uploaded later on.

Tenders shall be valid for a period of 180 days (both days inclusive i.e. the date of submission of tenders and the last date of period of validity of the Tender) from the date of submission of Tenders and shall be accompanied with a Tender security of the requisite amount mentioned in key details above.

Unsuccessful Applicants or Bidders may make a written request to the PEA for a debriefing. The PEA shall provide a timely and meaningful debriefing to the Applicant/Bidder informing on major shortcomings and weaknesses of the Application, respectively on the Offer in relation to the winning Bidder. No additional information shall be disclosed, the debriefing shall not include point-by-point comparisons with other Applications/Bidder's Offers and information that is confidential.

The Bids must be delivered to the address, on or before the date and time, as indicated in the Instructions to Bidders, clause 23.1. Late Bids will be rejected. Electronic Bid Submission shall be permitted and be handled as indicated in the Instructions to Bidders, clause 23.1.

In the first public Bid opening session, the Qualification Documents and the Technical Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives. In the second public Bid opening session, the Financial Bids of those Bidders who have fulfilled the qualification and technical requirements as per the Bidding Document will be opened.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security.
