Holiday allowance increased by 30% 455 jobs in MMRDA through Metro projects

Mumbai, February 2, 2017– The Metropolitan Commissioner, Mr. U.P.S. Madan, today, announced 30% increase in the Holiday Allowance for the employees who work on Saturday-Sunday and holidays to complete the job on hand on or before time. The Commissioner also mentioned that the four Metro corridors – Dahisar to DN Nagar, DN Nagar to Mankhurd, Wadala to Kasarwadavli and Dahisar (East) to Andheri (East) – covering almost 100 km distance has created 455 direct jobs in MMRDA resulting in many deserving employees earned promotions.
