

Chief Minister to inaugurate right side of Mankoli Naka flyover

Mumbai, April 7, 2017 – The Honourable Chief Minister of Maharashtra Mr. Devendra Fadnavis will inaugurate the right side of the 650-meter long Mankoli flyover tomorrow, Saturday, April 8, 2017 at 11 a.m. The ceremony will be held on the Mankoli flyover. The flyover was proposed considering the growing vehicular traffic on the Thane-Nashik highway.

The right side of the Mankoli flyover will provide four lanes and will be used for the up and down traffic. While the flyover will certainly reduce traffic jams and travel time on the Thane-Nashik highway, it will also save fuel and improve environment. Further, the Rs. 50.33-crore flyover is expected to facilitate seamless traffic flow at the Mankoli Naka and also clear traffic congestion in the city.

Also present on the occasion will be Mr. Eknath Shinde, Guardian Minister, Thane District, Dr. Ranjit Patil, Minister of State, Urban Development along with the local MP Mr. Kapil Patil and MLA Mr. Shantaram More.
