

403 MLD Surya Regional Water Supply Scheme Chief Minister to lay foundation stone on Monday

More than 20 lakh residents of Mira-Bhayander and Vasai-Virar to benefit

Mumbai, July 8, 2017 – It's the first for the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) – the 403 MLD Surya Regional Water Supply Scheme – and is set to benefit more than 20 lakh residents of Mira-Bhayander and Vasai-Virar areas.

The Honourable Chief Minister of Maharashtra Mr. Devendra Fadnavis will lay foundation stone for the Surya Regional Water Supply Scheme which will provide ample water to the 20 lakh residents of the Mira-Bhahayender and Vasai-Virar Municipal Corporations through 88-km long pipeline running from Suryanagar along ZP Road, State Highway and NH-8 to Ghodbunder Junction. The Mira-Bhayander Municipal Corporation will receive 218 MLD of water.

The Water Supply Scheme will be equipped with two pumping stations near Surya Dam and a water treatment plant at Suryanagar.

The ceremony is scheduled to be held on Monday, July 10, 2017 in the evening at 6.30 pm. at S.K. Stone, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Road, Mira Road (East).
