The Agenda Notes circulated by the Secretary, Executive Committee, were discussed and the following decisions taken :-

> Item No.1 : Action taken on the various items discussed in the meeting of the 13th January, 1976 :

I. Noted. The Municipal Commissioner and the Managing Director. C.I.D.C.C. are requested to expedite the action on the items pending with them, respectively.

Item No.2: Rules and procedure for the meetings of the Executive Committee Meetings :

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3. It was resolved to purchase the Ambassador Car No.MRZ-8682 from the C.I.D.C.C. at the depreciated cost of Rs.12.424/-. (In future. the kilometerage run by the vehicle should also be indicated in -the Agenda Note)

(b) <u>Bispersal of commercial activity</u> :

6. The need to undertake a detailed study for evolving a suitable policy was realised. Such a study will have to identify the implications of the possible policy alternatives. It was decided that a Study Group for this purpose could be set up under the B.M.R.D.A. Necessary Plan assistance should be sought from the State Government.

(c) Amendment to the Maharashtra Regional and Town Planning Act (MRTP Act);

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The points made by the Secretary. Urban Development, were appreciated 7. Further action would be initiated by him.

(d) Housing :

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The points brought out by Secretary. Urban Department. were appreciated. 8. It was agreed that the impact of decontrolling the rent both for residential and commercial accommodation would have to be examined in all its aspects. The main objectives of such a decontrol would be to promote increase in the housing -stock for residential purpose and reduction in the growth of commercial areas in the congested localities especially in South Bombay. 9. The need for taking a comprehensive look at the transport infra-structure in the Bombay Metropolitan Region was realised. It was felt that the Transport and Communications Board of the Authority should first take an overall view of Action the existing policies and action programmes of the various authorities operating Cha in this sector in the Metropolitan Region. . Item No.6 : Appointment of Typists :

The proposal to appoint three typists temporarily on the conditions mentioned 11. in the draft appointment letter was accepted. Further action in issuing -appointment order, etc. should be taken as the earliest. Metro

Item No.7 : Purchase of Furniture Items :

The proposals submitted to the Executive Committee relating to the pur-12. chase of some items of steel furniture to cover the immediate requirements was considered. The Executive Committee accepted the quantities of different furniture items as indicated in the Agenda Note and also the recommendations made-regarding the purchase from Messrs. Godrej Ltd. at the rates quoted. As these furniture items are immediately required for the Officers and staff joining the Authority. purchase action should be taken after obtaining the approval of the Chairman in anticipation of the Authority's sanction.

Item No.8 : Purchase of Electric Typewriter :

Approval was accorded to the purchase of one electric typewriter from 13. the Bindustan Teleprinters Ltd. . a Government of India undertaking. at a total cost of Rs.6.727.50. Approval of the Chairman of the Authority should be obtained before the purchase order is placed on the Firm.

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Item No.9 : Appointment of Clerk :

14. The proposal put before the Executive Committee for appointment of Shri A. D. Katare as a clerk on purely temporary basis was accepted. The appointment letter should be similar to the one approved in connection with the appointment of typists (Item No.6 above).

Item No. 10 : Loan assistance to Housing Board for

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upgradation of Slum Housing :-

It was noted from a further communication of Secretary (Housing) 15. that a similar scheme was being worked out by the Public Works and Dousing Department for financing by the Bombay District Central Cooperative Bank Ltd. As the scheme had to be basically accepted for implementation by the Maharashtra Housing Board, the Public Works and Housing Department of the Government of Maharashtra were asking the Housing Board to study the same and communicate their decision. In view of this, it was decided to postpone this item till a firm indication was available from the Secretary. Housing, regarding this.

Item No.11 : Other Items :

(a) Area Development Schemes :

The Chairman. Housing Renewal and Scology Board (HURE Board). 16. stressed the need for preparing specific schemes in the Metropolitan Region to be financed and/or executed by the Authority. He indicated that definite land development schemes near Bandra. Dharavi and the Backbay area were under examination/formulation under the HURE Board. He expected to finalise the schemes shortly during the next month or so and submit project reports for the consideration of the Executive ansp retary. so and submit project reports for the consideration of the Executive TE Board. Committee. This line of action was supported by the Executive Committee.

(b) Housing Board - New Setup :

17. The Chairman, HURE Board, indicated that there was need to have a clear definition of the relationship between the HURE Board of the BMNDA and the proposed reconstituted Housing Board for the Metropolitan Region. He felt that HURE Board of the B.M.R.D.A. can take up -tion by: meaningful programmes in the area only after the interlocking structure and interdependent relationship between these two Boards missioner. was properly defined. The Committee endorsed this view fully.
