Opening the discussion the Metropolitan Commissioner, BMRDA informed that very recently with the approval of the Cabinet a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been signed between BMRDA and IL&FS for development of Worli-Bandra Link as a tollway. Though the IL&FS has done the pre-feasibility study of the project through World Bank - approved consultants the BMRDA now proposes to formally study in detail the financial feasibility of the project through consultants. For this purpose an Experts' Committee will be appointed to draft Terms of Reference (TOR), select the consultants and monitor consultants work.

The Chief Secretary was of the view that apart from 2. the problems of fishermen, the project of such magnitude and nature requires detailed preinvestigations like soil and terrain study as also environmental impacts study. The Metropolitan Commissioner, BMRDA clarified that the all engineering aspects of the link have already been studied by the Public Works Department in the past. Apart from financial feasibility, the consultancy assignment will include study of environmental impacts of the link as per The Municipal Commissioner, clause No.3.2.9 of the TOR. BMC enquired about the role of the Experts' Committee and that of the Technical Committee which is being formulated under a separate item. It was clarified that the Experts' Committee is only for the financial feasibility study and will cease to exist once the report of the consultants was approved. With this clarification, the Executive Committee approved the proposal contained in Item Note and passed the following Resolution :-

"RESOLVED THAT the Executive Committee hereby accords its post-facto approval to the Terms of Reference (TORs), Letter of Invitation (LOI) and the short list of consultants enclosed along with the Item Note.
